



CURRENT SCHOLARSHIPS

McEachern High School PTSA Scholarship – Every year, McEachern recognizes several deserving seniors with a monetary scholarship. Scholarship money may be used at any vocational/technical school or four-year college or university. To be eligible, students must be a current member of the McEachern PTSA, have a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher, and will attend a vocational/technical school or a college/university during the 2012-2013 school year. Applications available in the BT Counseling Office. Completed application packets must be returned to the PTSA mailbox in Russell Hall. **Deadline March 30, 2012**

Janice M. Scott Memorial Scholarship – This scholarship is open to high school seniors. To apply you must be a US citizen or permanent resident, have a GOA of 3.0+, be a high school senior who will matriculate full-time at a US accredited four-year college/university in the US in the Fall of 2012, have demonstrated leadership abilities through participating in community service or other extra-curricular activities and the combined adjusted income of the parents cannot exceed \$100,000. Bill “Scoop” Kinney Journalism Scholarship - The Bill "Scoop" Kinney Journalism Scholarship was established in 2006 in honor of Mr. Bill Kinney, the senior editor of the Marietta Daily Journal. The scholarship is available to a student entering any accredited college or university, and planning to pursue a major in the fields of Journalism. Cobb School Counselors Association Son/Daughter Scholarship – CSCA presents a \$500 (non-renewable) scholarship every year to the son or daughter of a CSCA member. The CSCA member must have been a member for a minimum of three years. Applications are available in the BT scholarship drawer. **Postmark Deadline April 11, 2012. Nathaniel L.
