

Camp Overview

Lacrosse, developed by the Native Americans, is considered to be our nation's first sport. It is also one of the fastest growing team sports in the United States, seeing an increase of 138% in youth programs since 2001.



McEachern High School has successfully fielded both boys and girls lacrosse teams for several years, and we would like to expand these programs to the youth in our community.

Jr. Indian camp will teach middle school and incoming high school students with no lacrosse experience or knowledge the fundamental skills they need to be successful on the field. The camp will focus on catching, throwing, cradling, stick skills, and conditioning. This camp is designed to teach and improve the technical and tactical skills essential to quality lacrosse.

Through our fun and creative sessions, campers will be able to develop greater confidence in their abilities and a true love for the game of lacrosse.



Required Equipment

Campers will be required to bring the following equipment to camp each day:
